Competition rules

The competition will be held according the international rules for Youth ARDF championships on the 144 MHz and 3.5 MHz band for the categories W15 and M15 with ranking of indidividuals and teams. Only competitors born in 1992 or later are allowed to participate.

Technical parameters of the equipment

3.5 MHz RF power: 3 W;

Frequencies: MOE-MO5 3580 kHz, Beacon 3550 kHz;

Antenna: Vertical 8 meters long;

Grounding: Counterpoise 8 meters long.

144 MHz RF power: 1 W;

Frequencies: MOE-MO5 144525 kHz, Beacon 144825 kHz;

Antenna: Crossed Dipole 2.5 meters above the terrain.

Marking devices

Sport Ident system will be used..

Maps

The maps for both competitions will be IOF standard.

Fees

Competitors, Officials, Visitors: 150 Euro per person in total


